The 50/50 raffle will work as follows:

1. After members purchase tickets, the first ticket will be drawn as the 50/50 "player".
2. The "player" will randomly draw a playing card from a single-suit deck (1-in-14 chance).
 - a. If the drawn card is the Joker, they "win" one-half the raffle pot for that evening.
 - b. If it is not the Joker, the card is destroyed and one-half the raffle money is retained to be added to the winnings to next month.

When the prize has been won, the remaining cards of that suit will be destroyed and the next month starts the raffle prize over at the beginning. ❖

-HATCHEDIT, command line

Ever have a hatch that is not associative but it needs to be? The HATCHEDIT command will do a lot of things but it will not do this. Use the command line Hatch Edit, Associate (AS) option. This allows you to pick an internal point or select objects. No more delete & recreate!
